## **Description**

Castrol Optitemp™ 9890 (previously called Molub-Alloy 9890-2) is a premium synthetic lubricant which is especially recommended for the lubrication of plastic parts where minimum applications of lubricants is required.

Optitemp 9890 is a special purpose grease formulated from an advanced synthetic fluid and a thermally stable, non-soap base thickener. A blend of additives and lubricating solids ensure wear protection, therefore enabling long life of components.

### **Application**

Optitemp 9890 is especially suited to the lubrication of thermoplasts and duroplasts.

It may be used in continuous service from  $-45^{\circ}$ C to  $100^{\circ}$ C (-49 °F to 212 °F) and can be exposed to temperatures up to 120 °C (248 °F) intermittently.
